The NSW Hillclimb Panel and approved by the State Executive of CAMS, have had some rule changes added to the standard Supplementary Regulations and the Rules covering the Hillclimb Championship in NSW

These changes allow the running of non log booked cars in championship events.

This will allow the host clubs to fill the entries enabling the event to be viable and successful.

All the competitors must be members of a CAMS affiliated car club with the required licenses.

The cars will run in a separate class from the championship registered drivers and will not be eligible for points

Further supplementary regulation have be approved and issued by the Bathurst Light Car Club for the first and second rounds on the 1st & 2nd March
